Earlier in the year, we have explained some new initiatives that our foundation has promoted thanks to your help, in order to fully support family values, maternity, and human life in Democratic Republic of Congo, in particular in the capital Kinshasa.

Here the description of three projects that we are supporting.

The first project is about an orphanage. It is financed by private funds and includes the realization of a maternity unit where mothers can give birth to their children free of charge. Here they can keep babies with them and be assisted in case of necessity.

The second project's aim is the funding of an ambulance that can bring doctors to the poorest and most dangerous neighborhoods in Kinshasa to be able to give health care to abandoned children. The project is managed by a Catholic community and supervised by an Italian priest, don Maurizio.

The third project support the organization "Mamma Sofia" that brings help to public orphanages in Kinshasa. Thousands of abandoned children live in there in indescribable conditions due to a lack of funds.

During the health emergency period in Italy and in Europe, we have shared with you this video; in it Children in Congo have sent a message of encouragement to Italy, as simbol of european drama. In the past weeks, the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) declared a new Ebola epidemic in addition to Covid-19 health emergency.

The situation is critical and now your help is important more than ever. In this tragic moment. It is essential to support mothers, families and children in the streets. "Mamma Sofia" association has started the distribution of the first few hundreds of facemasks to children, boys and girls on the streets of Kinshasa but it is really important to do more.
